In 2019-2020, The Civil War Round Table of New York will celebrate its 69th Season, making it one of the oldest Round Tables dedicated to the study of America's Civil War.

The club will meet generally on the second Wednesday of the month in September, October, and November, and then from January to May.

Meetings are held at **The 3 West Club**, at 3 West 51st Street in Manhattan.

Our **Expert Speakers** address a wide variety of Civil War related topics, often from their own published material. Also, there are frequent updates about preservation strategies of battlefields and other sites.

Recent past speakers have included "**Legends**" like Ed Bearss, James I. Robertson, Jr., James McPherson, Harold Holzer, Allen Guelzo, Dennis Fyre and Frank O'Reilly among others.

Our January meeting is **Lee/Jackson Night**, when a speaker discusses these generals or a related Southern topic.

The **Barondess/Lincoln Award** is presented each February to any person or institution for contributing to the greater appreciation of the life and work of Abraham Lincoln. Named in memory of Benjamin Barondess, a CWRTNY founding member, the award has been presented since 1962.

The Fletcher Pratt Literary Award is presented in May to the author or editor of the best non-fiction book about the Civil War published during the previous calendar year. Named in memory of Fletcher Pratt, journalist, author, and CWRTNY charter member, the award has been presented annually since 1956.

The **Bell I. Wiley Award** honors the non-literary and/or the artistic talents of those who have contributed to a greater understanding and preservation of any aspect of the Civil War.

The **James I. Robertson Young Reader Award** acknowledges significant literary contributions, fiction or non-fiction, about the Civil War for elementary and high school students and has been recently renamed for the renowned historian.

The Round Table conducts an annual trip to a Civil War battlefield or related historical site. **Battlefield Tours** have been made to Gettysburg, Petersburg, Appomattox, Shiloh, Richmond, Vicksburg, and other famous locations.
