Mike Fitzpatrick Patrick Cleburne

Mike retired from a career in supermarket management and was the past president of the Nassau County Civil War Round Table. So come join us as Mike takes us through the incredible life and career of Major General Patrick Cleburne

A native of County Cork, Ireland, Patrick Cleburne, was one of the South's greatest commanders during the American Civil War. No Irish-born soldier rose higher in the ranks in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. He was held in high esteem by nearly all his subordinates, his fellow officers and even those who fought against him. To President Jefferson Davis, he was the "Stonewall of the West"; to General Robert E. Lee, he was "a meteor shining from a clouded sky". But a proposal he would make in 1864 would be a possible reason he was never to achieve the higher rank he most notably deserved.
